Call to order

Public Safety

FAKE 911 CALLS - George Testman(d) – An adult sometime resident of 1108 Edie Avenue was arrested in connection for the false 911 calls. His bond was lowered from \$4,000 to \$1,000. Not sure if they will carry a felony charge, if they don't our community prosecutor (Zone 6 Keith Lamar JR) wouldn't get involved.

Good News for Local Juveniles – Two youngsters who have been staying at a relative's house in the neighborhood and who been involved in several unfortunate incidents in the neighborhood have moved out of the Atlanta area to stay with a new guardian and attend school elsewhere. The children's mother fully supported the effort to give these children a better chance. They started school this week at their new location. A neighbor who helped arrange this transition will keep us updated on their progress.

General Public Safety – A question was asked about an arrest involving an adult who has ties to the neighborhood (due to relatives who still live here) for the possession of a firearm by a felon, there are questions on if he actually a felon. BOHO Public Safety will be investigating this.

Trolley Patrol - SAND wide private paid security patrol supported through individual home subscriptions currently at \$30.00 monthly for residents. Discounts offered if you pay quarterly or yearly. Trolley Patrol accepts donations from households that can't afford a whole subscription, but the more subscribers, the more hours of officers patrolling our neighborhood in addition to APD. SAND Update

What is SAND? - SAND along with NPU-W are our official avenues of communication with the City of Atlanta. SAND covers from I-20 to McDonough (Prison), from the Eastern border of Grant Park to Moreland Avenue (West Side) It encompasses 7 neighborhoods, Benteen Park, Boulevard Heights, Glenwood Park, Ormewood Park, North Ormewood Park, McDonough/Guice, Woodland Hills.

Zoning Review Board Meeting

On August 8th the Zoning Review Board (ZRB) will review legislation introduced by Council Member Smith at the request of the neighborhoods. This legislation supports the BeltLine Sub-Area 4 Master Plan and the wishes of the neighborhoods for 800 and 860 Glenwood Avenue to have a good mix of residential and retail space. This legislation would rezone the property from Industrial to Mixed Use Residential Commercial. The current zoning (Industrial) is in conflict with the BeltLine plans.

It is critical that as many people as possible attend this event in support of the legislation. The neighborhoods will only have 10 minutes to speak, so please do not sign up for comment; rather, when the Zoning Review Board asks who in attendance is in favor of this legislation, please stand in order to be counted.

Proactive Rezonings & Transit-Oriented Development

From 2007 to 2012, members of the community worked with the City of Atlanta and Atlanta BeltLine, Inc. (ABI) to produce 10 subarea master plans, which were adopted by Atlanta City Council. These master plans laid out the parks, trails, transportation, and land use recommendations to help fulfill the Atlanta BeltLine vision. Part of that vision is Transit-Oriented Development: pedestrian and bicycle-friendly urban infill around the planned transit investment.

The next step in realizing the Atlanta BeltLine vision is a multi-year effort to rezone specific parcels per the recommendations in the master plans. The City of Atlanta's Department of Planning and Community Development, with support from ABI, will initiate proactive rezonings in key redevelopment areas identified in the master plans.

The proactive rezoning will occur in the three phases:

Phase 1	Subareas 3, 5, 9	(Kickoff Summer 2013)
Phase 2	Subareas 1, 4, 7, 10	(Kickoff in early 2014)
Phase 3	Subareas 2, 6, 8	(Kickoff in late 2014)

The City of Atlanta and ABI have combined their community engagement efforts to ensure the creation a series of opportunities for public input. The BeltLine Subarea 3 includes portions of the Chosewood Park, Grant Park, Boulevard Heights, and Ormewood Park neighborhoods and portions of NPUs W and Y. Below is the public outreach schedule for the rezonings in the Subarea 3 study area. Please attend to learn more information about the proactive rezonings planned for Sub Area 3.

Strikemaster II Pro Group Buy

Did you know that according to crime statistics, 80% of entries occur through the door, most by forced entry or kick-ins? The cost for Strikemaster installation is:

- \$45 service call (1 time charge/household)
- \$120 per door (\$80 for Strikemaster II Pro + \$40.00 for installation). There are also now several solutions for French Doors.

The installation includes the door frame reinforcer, including allowing for alarm system contacts, door edge pro for reinforcement of the door at the deadbolt site, and replacing some screws in the hinges with 3" screws.

This offer is valid throughout 2013.


We also need to check on the fire hydrant at Morley & Hamilton as it has been leaking.
